The Catholic Church requires (Canon 874.1) the following of godparents:

- ✘ Chosen by the parents or guardians
- ✘ At least 16 years of age
- ✘ Catholics who have been Confirmed and received the Holy Eucharist
- ✘ Leading a life in harmony with the faith and be practicing Catholics
- ✘ If married, be in a valid Catholic marriage
- ✘ Not the father or mother of the one to be baptized

The parents may choose one or two godparents. If they choose two, one should be male and the other female. The Catholic Church allows (Canon 874.2) a second baptized (non-Catholic) person to be admitted as witness to the baptism, along with a Catholic who serves as the primary sponsor/godparent
