There will be no Sacrament of Reconciliation on Fridays at 4 pm and Saturdays at 10 am during July and August. It will begin in September.

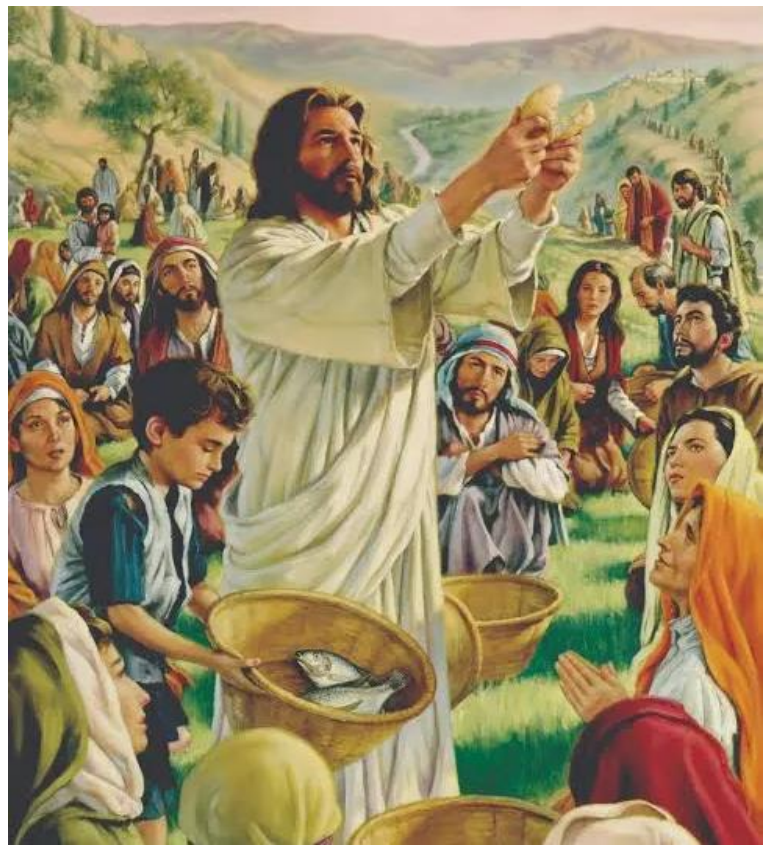
Reconciliation is also available by appointment Wednesday through Friday before or after Mass; please call or send appointment requests to oassist@stignatius.ca
