The Sacrament of Reconciliation is regularly available Fridays at 4 pm, and Saturdays at 10 am.

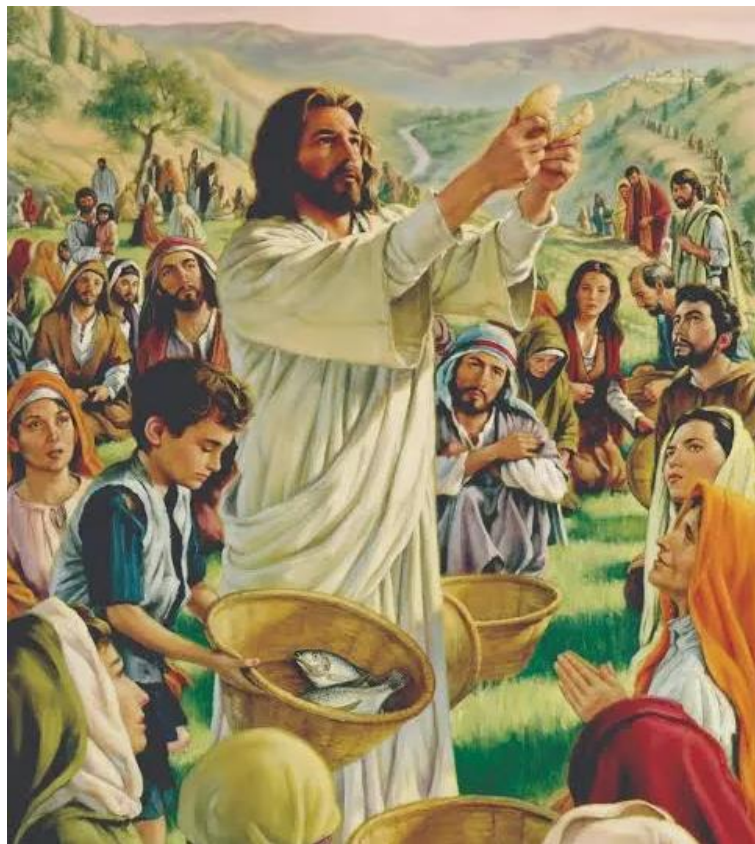
Reconciliation is also available by appointment Wednesday through Friday before or after Mass; please call or send appointment requests to oassist@stignatius.ca
