Nicene Creed

This year marks the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea (in modern-day Turkiye). In the year 325, some 318 bishops gathered in Nicaea for an ecumenical council to discuss matters of great importance to the church. One of the greatest achievements was the definition of the faith in the form of a creed. Several years later, in 381, the Creed was endorsed by the 150 bishops gathered in a new ecumenical council at Constantinople, notably with a few additions on the Holy Spirit. We know this Creed today as the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed.



Since the 1960's, in Canada, we have prayed the Apostles' Creed at Sunday Masses and Solemnities. The Apostles' Creed, whose present form is similar to the baptismal creed used in Rome in the second and third centuries, actually developed from questions addressed to those seeking baptism.

To highlight the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea, the Council of Priests have recommended that the Nicene Creed be used, throughout the Archdiocese, in 2025. The Archbishop has encouraged us, throughout 2025, to pray the Nicene Creed at all Sunday Masses and Solemnities from the Solemnity of the Epiphany (January 5, 2025) to the Feast of the Holy Family, (December 28, 2025).

However, during the Lenten and Easter seasons the Apostles' Creed will be used. The Archbishop hopes that the use of the Nicene Creed, throughout 2025, will unveil for us the rich theological beauty of this ancient profession of faith.

Advance Medical Care Planning and Surrogate Decision Making

Please join us at St. Ignatius Parish on **February 1st from 1 pm to 2:30** for an educational session on advanced medical care planning and surrogate decision making. This event will take place in the Church.

The educational presentation will be provided by Katarina Lee-Ameduri, Director of Ethics for the Reseau Compassion Network and Assistant Professor in the Department of Family Medicine at the University of Manitoba.

The presentation will be followed by a panel discussion of a fictional ethics case with experts including: Professor Mary J. Shariff (Faculty of Law, University of Manitoba), AnnaMarie Bogdan (RN, BN), and Father Sam Argenziano (retired parish priest). The event is hosted by Fr. Daryl Miranda, S.J. (pastor of St. Ignatius Parish).
