Communion Service on Tuesday, February 18th at 11:00 am

There will not be a Mass on **Tuesday, February 18th**. Instead there will be a **Communion Service at 11:00 am**. The reason for this change is because this year marks the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea held in 325. The 318 bishops gathered at the Council, in modern day Turkiye, promulgated the definition of faith, the Nicene Creed. The original Creed adopted in 325 was amended in 381 by the First Council of Constantinople; thus, it is formally known as the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed. To mark this milestone anniversary, a **Study Day** has been organized for the clergy of the Archdioceses of St. Boniface and Winnipeg and of the Archeparchy of Winnipeg.
