
2024 WINDOW REPLACEMENT

Phase 1 of the window replacement took place in the summer of 2023 when all of the upper windows in the church were replaced.

Phase 2 is scheduled for the summer of 2024. This is required window replacement to maintain our facility and control our energy costs. Project costs are \$33k and we need your help funding this critically needed work.
