All who cannot attend are invited to join us on line.

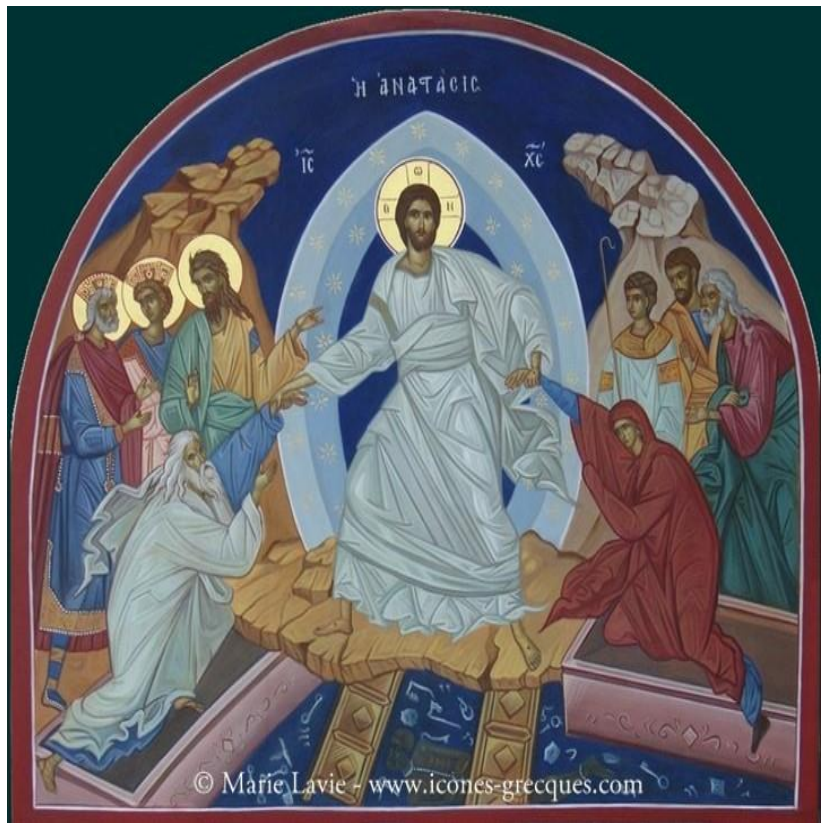
The Sacrament of Reconciliation is regularly available Fridays at 4 pm, and Saturdays at 10 am.
